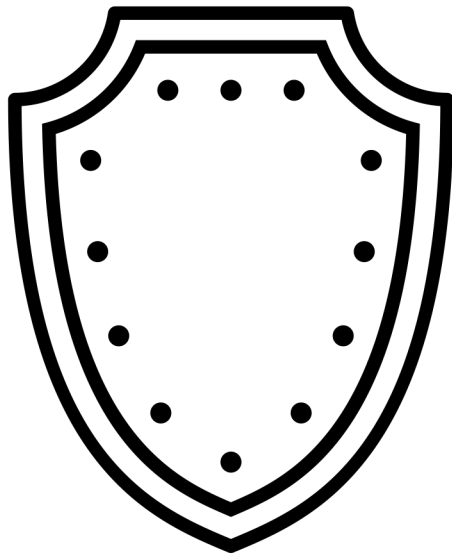

WHAT DATA TO UPLOAD

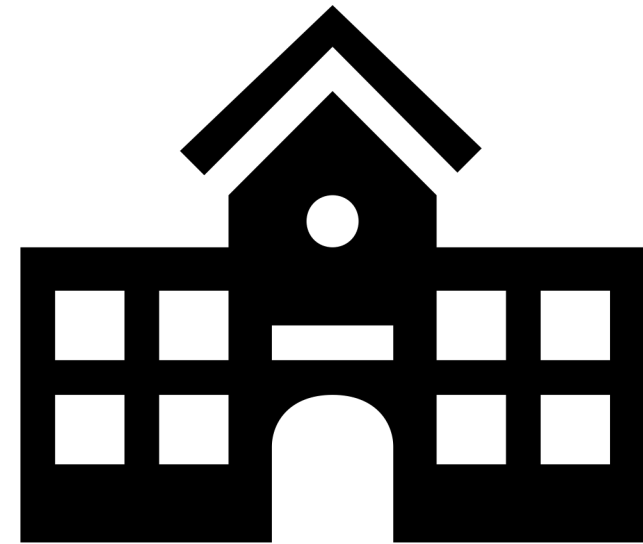
Club

A group of people who take part in a sport or activity. Examples include a soccer team, a hillwalking club or an active retirement group



Activity location

Any place where physical activity is carried out. Examples include a football ground, a town park, a beach, a leisure centre



HOW TO UPLOAD DATA



- There are two ways to upload data:
- **Single upload** – Use a web form to enter the details of one club or activity location
- **Bulk upload** – Use an Excel template to enter the details of multiple clubs or activity locations. Each row in the spreadsheet holds one club or activity location

This survey collects information on sports facilities and activity locations for the [National Database of Sport & Recreation Amenities](#), an innovative and exciting initiative led by Sport Ireland. The project has strong support from across government and is being implemented in conjunction with Local Authorities, State Agencies and National Governing Bodies of Sport (NGBs).

Sport Ireland, in line with the Government's National Sports Policy, have led on the development of a National Database of Sport & Recreation Amenities. A primary aim is to increase physical activity levels across the population of Ireland, by providing a single portal for the public to find opportunities to be active, including clubs, facilities, public places, and trails.

As well as increasing the visibility of facilities and clubs, the database aims to improve how recreational amenities are planned, funded, and managed in Ireland.

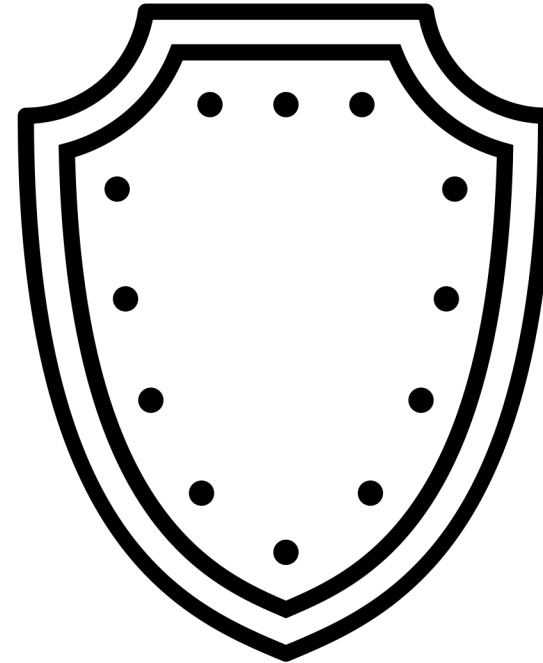

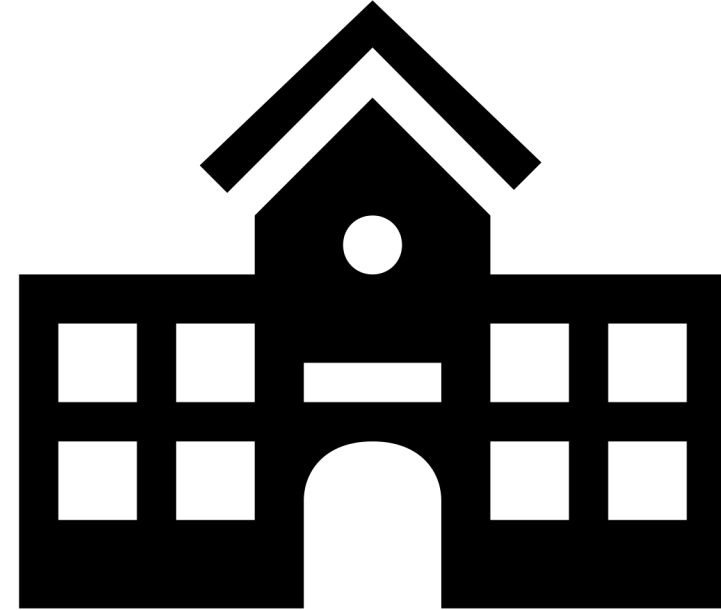

DATA PROTECTION & GDPR

Personal data

- Information that may identify a person
- Cannot handle or process without a clear consent
- Data must be used only for the purpose it was provided

Potentially person data

- Contact details for club/facilities
 - Phone numbers
 - Non-generic email addresses
 -  info@club.ie or club@gmail.com
 -  johnsmith@gmail.com or krfc@yahoo.ie

DATA PROTECTION & GDPR

Recommended approach

1. Single club/facility forms:
 - Clear consent at source – always ok
2. Bulk data forms:
 - Current agreements with clubs have clear consent – can provide all data
 - If not, can provide bulk data with Potentially Personal Data removed
3. Future
 - Include clear consent in future registration process
