

# Uploading Club Data – Guide for Local Authorities

## Clubs

A Club is a group of people who take part in a sport or activity. Examples include a soccer team, a hillwalking club or an active retirement group. For this project, a Club is not a physical place, like a GAA Ground; this would be considered an Activity Location.

## Data Template

- You can [download the Club bulk template spreadsheet on this webpage](#).
- Click the “Download” button in the top right of the page.
- It will download a Zip file. A Zip file is a compressed version of a file – in this case the Excel template. [More info on how to open Zip files](#).
- Open the Zip file and it will contain an Excel file named ‘Club bulk upload form v2.0.xlsm’
- When you open the Excel file make sure you click the “Enable macros” option. Macros are little rules inside the Excel file we use to ensure data quality.
- Email the completed Excel spreadsheet back to us, and we will upload it to the website.

Email the completed spreadsheet back to us, and we will check it, then upload it to the website.

## Data Fields to Enter

It is strongly encouraged to include information for all the fields if possible. This will allow the public to find clubs more easily and will help Local Authorities with their analysis and development work. However, some are considered *required*, other *recommended*, while others are *optional*. If a field is marked as required and the information is not filled in, the submission will not be accepted for upload.

We hope you can have the completed templates back to us by **May 26<sup>th</sup>**.

The following table gives details and instructions for all fields in the Club bulk upload template.
